

***COUNTY GUIDELINES FOR MOTOR VEHICLES**

In consideration for the privilege of parking in the parking lot of Lloyd C. Bird High School ("School"), the student ("Student") and his/her parent or guardians ("Parent") by signing agree to pay an annual fee, understand the "You Need to Know" statement, and to abide by the following conditions:

- The student promises to obey all laws, policies, rules and regulations, both current and hereafter promulgated, pertaining to the student's use of motor vehicles on school grounds. In addition, the Student promises to obey all school rules and regulations pertaining to the use of the school parking lot and driving on school grounds as well as the rules and regulations identified in the STANDARDS FOR STUDENT CONDUCT and the Student Handbook. Special school regulations may be listed on this form.
- Approval of parking privileges on school property may be revoked at any time by the principal, at the principal's sole discretion, for good cause. Good cause shall include, but shall not be limited to, unsafe driving on school premises or while driving to and from school. In this regard, the principal may request, at any time, a copy of the driving record of any student applying, or who have been approved, to park on the school premises. The student and his/her parents do hereby agree to provide the student's driving record when requested and understand that failure to do so shall cause parking privileges to be revoked. If parking privileges are revoked the annual parking fee will be forfeited.
- The school disclaims all responsibility for loss or damage from fire, theft or any other cause to the Student's vehicle or personal property contained therein while the vehicle is parked on school property. The School specifically disclaims liability for the loss or damage to Student's vehicle or property contained therein resulting from the School's negligence. The agreement provides only for the rental of parking space to the Student by the School and is not intended in any way to create a bailment with respect to the Student's vehicle and the personal property therein.
- The Student and registered owners of vehicles listed above agree to maintain, now and in the future, the minimum amount of liability insurance required by Virginia law on the described vehicles at all times when the vehicle is parked on the School property.

LLOYD C.BIRD PARKING REGULATIONS

- The parking permit is to be used on the listed automobiles only. The permit may NOT be used on other vehicles!
- The 15MPH speed limit is to be observed on all parking lots and roadways, bus loops, etc.
- Vehicles must be parked properly between the painted lines in their assigned lot.
- Reckless driving will not be permitted!
- Students driving to school are expected to report to first period on time.
- Drivers are to use caution when leaving or entering the parking lot.
- Should your vehicle be vandalized/damaged, it must be reported to the police department and school administration.
- Students may not return to their vehicles between classes or during lunch periods without a valid pass.
- Parking privileges may be suspended or revoked for breaking line, driving in the on-coming lane, etc.
- Lost or stolen permits must be reported to the administration immediately.
- There will be a \$5 fee for replacement of lost or stolen parking permits.
- Only students who have been instructed to do so may park in the lower lot.
